- Created by the CPUC to accelerate energy efficiency adoption and support CA climate and environmental & social justice (ESJ) goals
 - \$320M investment over eight years
 - Administered by Resource Innovations with input from Market Transformation Advisory Board
 - Develops and oversees a portfolio of statewide market transformation initiatives (MTIs)



Market Transformation


"The strategic process of intervening in a market to create lasting change by removing market barriers or exploiting opportunities, accelerating the adoption of identified technologies or practices."

- Ensure selected initiatives meet MT criteria
- Collaborate with existing EE efforts
 - Avoid duplication
 - Faster scale
- Contribute to statewide energy savings
- Advance other state goals:
 - GHG emissions reduction.
 - Workforce education & training
 - Environmental and social justice (ESJ)
 - Grid flexibility

CalMTA is a program of the California Public Utilities Commission (CPUC) and is administered by Resource Innovations




Shape California's MT portfolio

Request for Ideas timeline






RFI questions



- 13 questions, ~250-word limit/question
- Product description & benefits
- Target market description
 - Sector and delivery channel
 - Estimated rate of adoption
- Barriers to adoption
 - Market and technical barriers
 - Competitive landscape
- Additional information available?





Scoring criteria



- Total System Benefit (TSB)
- Product readiness
- Estimated MTI cost and cost-effectiveness
- ESJ / equity impacts
- Non-Energy Benefits (NEBs)
- MT alignment (innovation, market leverage, sustainability)

Note: all categories calculated and scored by CalMTA






RFI Q&A board
